Note: You'll need a grown-up helper to lead this game in order to read and hand out the cards.

4. The youngest player goes first.

How to set up

1. Spread out the playing mat.
2. Pick the level of play best suited to each player: yellow (beginner) or blue (advanced.) Put away the cards you are not using.
3. All players should line up a few steps away from the mat. Yellow-level players should stand two feet from the mat.

Note: Blue-level players should stand four feet from the mat.

How to play

1. On your turn, toss a beanbag onto the mat and try to make it land on one of the letters. You get up to three tries per turn. Stop tossing as soon as you land on a letter.
2. Draw one card from the deck and follow the challenge on the card.
