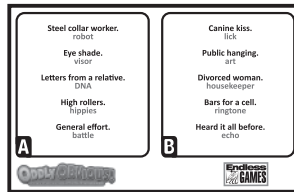


## GET READY TO PLAY:

- Choose one player to act as host and read the clues and distribute tokens.
- All other players sit so that they can see the front of the card.
- Choose whether you will be playing the A rounds or the B rounds per card, and use only that side of the card per game



Card Front



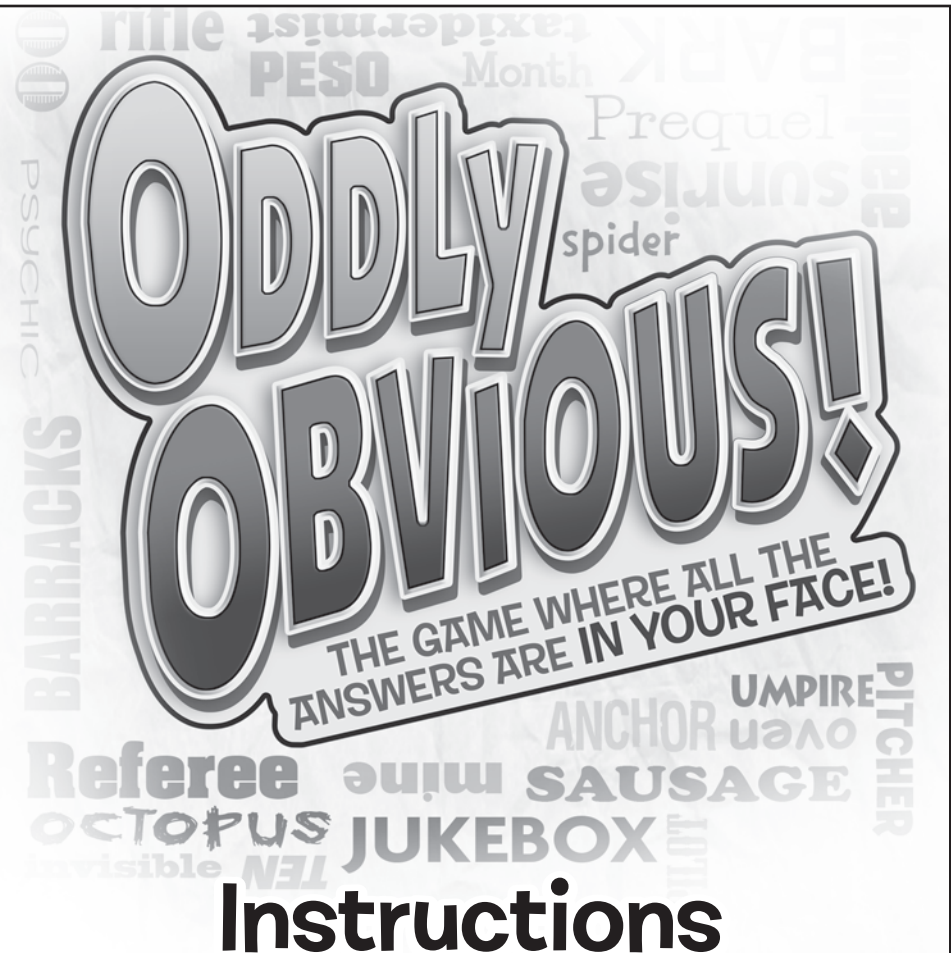
Card Back

## LET'S PLAY!

1. The host chooses a card and places it in the card stand. He then reads the first clue from the A or B side as selected before the game.
  2. All Players Look at the front of the card and try to find the word on the front of the card that corresponds with the clue.
- NOTE: The clues can be clever in their wording – for example the word “Octopus” might correspond to the clue “Army Animal” because an octopus has a lot of arms and is therefore “army”.
3. The first Player to shout out the correct answer earns one of the 5 tokens. Only one guess per player per clue.
  4. Play continues in this format until all 5 clues for the round have been read (and all 5 tokens have been won).

At the end of the round, the team (or player) with the most tokens wins that card.

5. Continue playing A (or B) rounds on other cards until 1 team (or player) has won 5 cards.



## Instructions

- 3 or more players
- Ages 12 +

### CONTENTS:

- 5 Correct Answer Tokens
- 147 Game Cards - two rounds per card (A & B)
- 1 Card Stand
- 1 Instructions

### OBJECT:

**TEAM PLAY** (4 or more players, in 2 teams): First team to collect 5 cards wins.

**INDIVIDUAL PLAY** (3 players): The first player to collect 5 cards wins.
