

LIGHTNING ROUND:

In the Lightning Round you'll have 60 seconds to guess 10 words before the buzzer sounds. Use the down arrow on your DVD remote to reveal each password. You can pass on words but you must go back and answer them to win! Once you've correctly answered all 10 words press the VICTORY button - if you make it through the Lightning Round you'll earn an extra 100 bonus points!

Decide which team member will give the clues - you won't need the decoder glasses, just use your remote's down button to reveal the next word. Clue Guesser - sit with your back to the TV, facing the group, and get ready to answer.

Important Production Note:

It's important to note that everyone's TV screens display pictures differently - this means you might be able to read the secret password even if you're not wearing the decoder glasses. By adjusting your color or picture levels you should be able to disguise the word - you can see a test setup screen in the INSTRUCTIONS, selectable from the main menu. But just in case you cannot disguise the word, don't peek at the screen if you're trying to guess the password!

DVD Edition INSTRUCTIONS:

For 2 teams of 2 (or more) players:

Object:

Password™, the DVD edition of the classic TV game, will provide many hours of stimulating entertainment. The OBJECT of the game is to score points by guessing the correct "PASSWORD" from one-word clues given to you by your partner.

DVD host Charmin' Chuck Harmon will guide you through 2 Password rounds, after which, the team with the most points moves onto the Lightning Round.

Contents:

- 2 Pairs of Secret Password Reveal Glasses
- 1 DVD Game
- 1 Instructions Sheet

Set Up:

To play Password™ in its “true TV format”, you will need 4 players.

NOTE: To play a variation of Password with only 3 players, simply keep the same “steady clue-giver” throughout the game, and have that person give clues to both teams.

For more than 4 players, play in teams or create your own Password™ Tournament!

Setting Up the DVD:

Insert the Game DVD into the player. After a short introduction, the Main Menu will appear. Choose one player to operate the remote while navigating the Main Menu. During the Password and Lightning Rounds, the Clue Givers will navigate through the screens.

Use the arrow keys on your remote to navigate between menu items. To advance screens, press the center or enter button.

Begin a new Password™ game by selecting NEW GAME from the main menu. After an introduction from Charmin' Chuck you'll be given the first Password. Good Luck!

NOTE: The words in the Password™ DVD Edition are presented completely at random. You may reach a point where you'll see a repeated word, but with over 1500 words that should take a while!

How to Play:

Password™ is played with 2 teams of 2 (or more) players. Here's how it works:

PASSWORD ROUND:

You'll be given a password on your television screen which can only be seen by the teammate wearing the Secret Password Decoder Glasses. That player will try to get his partner to guess the word by giving a simple one-word clue. If the partner guesses the word in 10 seconds or less, the team earns 10 points!

If the partner answers incorrectly, the word passes to the other team who then gets a chance to guess it. If they guess incorrectly, the word goes back to the first team, and so on. Point values decrease by 1 point for each incorrect answer until one team guesses the password.

NOTE: For each word, if the score reaches zero (teams have guessed incorrectly a combined 10 times), neither team earns points, and the round continues with a new Password.

Score will be kept on screen for your convenience. To ensure correct scoring, make sure you alternate which team guesses first for each successive password.

The game consists of 2 rounds of 5 words each. Make sure you switch which partner wears the glasses and gives the clues for the second round. At the end of the second round the team with the highest score is the champion and moves on to the Lightning Round!
