

Synopsis:
A BEE C Match Game is a fast-paced letter matching game for all ages. You don't have to know how to spell to play and you don't have to be a spelling bee champ to win. Simply match letter to letter and collect 7 cards to win.

Rules:
For 2 players or 2 teams
Contents:

- 20 Cards, each with 1 image showing the corresponding 3 letter word on each side (a total of 40 words and images)
- 22 Letter dice
- 1 Bee shaped carry case which splits to become two dice cups

Set Up:

- Shuffle cards
- Place 3 cards facing the same direction on the table.
- Place remaining stack aside.
- Deal each player (or team) eleven dice.

Start:
Each player (or one player from each team) rolls just one die. The player who rolls the letter closest to the beginning of the alphabet goes first. In the event of a tie, the dice are rolled again.

## Playing the Game:

The player places all of their eleven dice in one half of the bee dice cup, shakes the cup, and spills the dice. The player then places all of the corresponding dice on the cards (ie: if they have a " C " and a " T " and the word "CAT" is on one of the cards in play, the player must play those matching letters on the card). The player does this for all three cards in play, matching as many letters as possible. When the player has exhausted all moves, their opponent takes his/her turn, repeating the same actions.

## Scoring:

If, at any point, a player completes the spelling of a word, they collect the card and the dice on it. For example: if Player One had placed down the "C" and "T" in "CAT" and Player Two subsequently rolls the " A " to compete the word, Player Two collects the card and dice. Each card collected represents a "point". Each time a point is scored, and a card taken from play, a new card is taken from the stack and placed in play, so that there are always three cards in play at all times.
The player may use the dice collected in future play.

## Winning the Game:

Play continues until one player wins by accumulating 7 point cards.

## Alternate "Long" Game:

Play continues until one player collects all 22 dice.
